Requirements:

- High school graduate as of May/June 2023 planning to attend **OR** a student currently enrolled at an institution of higher education
- Applicant must be employed by or have an immediate family member employed by a company that is a member of the Sheboygan County Chamber of Commerce.
- Applicant must demonstrate a capacity for leadership.
- Applicant must show an interest in community and school activities.
- Applicant must complete Section II and must submit a typed essay on a separate document
